### **Stacked Turf Face of the Bunkers on the 18<sup>th</sup> Hole**

The newly constructed stacked turf faces of the two bunkers in front of the 18<sup>th</sup> green are to be classified as “ground under repair.”

Therefore, if your ball comes to rest on the stacked turf face, you must take relief by removing your ball and dropping it within one club’s length of the “nearest point of relief”, which is not in the hazard and not nearer the hole.

**This local rule must only be used if you ball actually lies on the turf surface of the stacked face.** If you ball lies in any part of the bunker itself, the ball is in the hazard and must be played from the hazard, or appropriate relief taken under penalty.
